

e-fellows.net is the first company to award an online scholarship in Europe to the most talented and successful students. The objective of this private sector initiative is to cultivate these talents by offering them comprehensive Internet research possibilities and services as well as to create a unique network for their studies and career.

e-fellows.net was founded in the spring of 2000 by Deutsche Telekom, the Georg von Holtzbrinck publishing group, and McKinsey & Company. Its sponsor partners are Accenture, Allianz, Bosch, Clifford Chance, Deutsche Bank, DiamondCluster International, Freshfields Bruckhaus Deringer, Hengeler Mueller, KPMG, Peek & Cloppenburg, and Roche Diagnostics.

Online scholarship

The first online scholarship in Europe is the core element of e-fellows.net. Undergraduate, postgraduate, and PhD students can apply for this on the www.e-fellows.net webpage.

e-fellows.net cultivates its scholars with the following services:

- Possibility of researching 3,000 databases and publications free of charge (e.g., Business Source Premier, juris, GENIOS, Nature, and TEMA)
- Internet access free of charge (T-DSL-Flat or 30 hours per month analog)
- Personal contacts to the business world based on the mentor program
- Participation in exclusive events and workshops (e.g., McKinsey: Summer Academy; Telekom: First Steps event)
- Internships, diploma theses, and job offers
- Active participation in the e-fellows.net network (city groups, scholar meetings)

The online scholarship is aimed mainly at those studying law, business/economics, natural sciences, and engineering. In the case of other disciplines, we expect students to demonstrate a high level of interest in business topics (e.g., through internships or minor subjects studied). To be accepted into the scholarship program, all applicants have to have very good academic achievements, internships, and stays abroad as well as be engaged in extra-curricular activities.

The initial scholarship period is one year. It is however possible to extend this until completion of studies. e-fellows.net offers scholars who are recent graduates access to attractive programs run by partner companies.

In addition to the online scholarship, e-fellows.net supports students of all disciplines throughout their studies by providing current news and information on studies and careers, tips and tricks for semesters abroad, and of course an attractive online job and internship market.
